It is a very exciting time for the children of Holy Family school. In 2016 our enrolment was 125 children, 142 in 2017 and as of September 2018 it looks like we are going to have 150+. The increase last year meant that we could split our 3rd and 4th classes. If we continue to grow, we will be able to split our 5th and 6th classes. So we need your help - If you know of anyone moving to the area or looking for a placement in any class from Junior Infants right up to 6th class, please tell them about all the wonderful work and activities going on in Holy Family school. Splitting our 5th and 6th classes will guarantee all the pupils of Holy Family a pupil-teacher ratio of less than 22:1. This is lower than the national average (most schools have over 30 children per teacher) and will provide wonderful learning opportunities for all of our children.
